Welcome Aboard!

You step on to the wide swim grid, up the steps and onto the Aft Deck.

- the extended swim grid has removable staples
- access to a large lazarette for storage and the new generator
- the nameplate has raised backlit lettering
- new teak decking
- a large marble table invites al fresco dining
- a wet bar and fridge make entertaining easy
- a television
- infrared heating
- full enclosure

The Salon is entered through wide sliding doors from the aft deck. You may be impressed by the contemporary elegance of this room. The open layout, large windows and 7-foot ceiling add to the spacious, comfortable feel.

- wall coverings, upholstery and furniture are very stylish
- large luxurious lounging sofa
- 2 coffee tables
- full bar with white marble counter-top
- Frigidaire fridge, ice make and sink
- new 68" flat screen television
- KVH satellite television
- exceptional sound system

The Dining Room has granite topped cabinets and serving areas along both sides.

The Master Stateroom on the main deck and is accessed through a Private Study.

The Lounge behind helm is perfect for rainy days or escaping from too much sun.

- crushed recycled glass counter-tops and cocktail tables
- a wet bar with fridge
