Silverton introduced of the 351 Sedan in 1997. Silverton engineers came up with a dramatically different approach to the design of the modern family cruiser. All manufacturers recognize the appeal of a roomy interior, but Silverton made it happen with the introduction of their "SideWalk" concept, a series of molded steps on the starboard side of the boat leading from the foredeck up to the flybridge and then down again to the cockpit. The result of this clever design is a spacious full-width salon with the floor space of a much larger boat. Built on a modified-V hull with side exhausts and prop pockets, the engines are located aft, beneath the cockpit rather than under the salon, which allows the cabin floor to sit low in the hull. Lacking side decks, the interior is huge and the apartment-sized galley will be a real crowd-pleaser, but with only a single stateroom these expansive living areas come as no great surprise. A pair of glass sliding doors open to a spacious cockpit, and the flybridge is arranged with a walkaround centerline helm and lounge seating forward. No racehorse, 320hp V-drive gas engines cruise at 14-15 knots and reach a top speed in the mid 20s.

Accommodations

The 351 Silverton has the feel of a larger boat because of the full beam salon. There is so much natural light coming into the salon and galley that you barely feel that you are inside. You enter the salon via a large sliding glass door, down one solid step. To port is a convertible dinette and to starboard is a sleeper sofa. The open galley is also on the starboard side, a mere step down from the salon. The master stateroom is in the forepeak and features a centerline queen and ample storage, in fact the entire boat is loaded with storage spaces. A head with separate stall shower is located on the port side opposite the galley. The interior is decorated in light, neutral colors with medium wood trim and some aqua accents and shows very well.
