Stairs from the swim platform to the aft deck, several to the flybridge and then stairways on both sides to the foredeck. Several stairs on port from the aft deck to the main salon with galley and dinette forward. Master stateroom aft with queen bed to starboard and head with separate stall shower to port. Guest stateroom forward has another head with separate stall shower as well.
