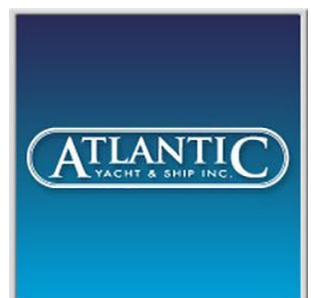

STANDARD EQUIPMENT

CONSTRUCTION

- Design made following European Directive requirements and according to CE certification
- Monolithic hull in polyester
- Monolithic structural hull liner bonded to the hull
- Deck injection constructed in glass fibre and Saerform foam sandwich, covered with "diamond-point" non-slip coating
- Hull-deck joint screwed, bonded and trimmed with 1 toerail
- Cast iron keel fixed with bolts and stainless steel backing plates
- 2 Underhung rudders with stainless steel stock
- White hull - Grey metal hull decoration

DECK EQUIPMENT

RIGGING

- Standard mast 9/10 anodized aluminum installed on the deck, 2 sets of spreaders
- Anodized aluminum boom
- Discontinuous stainless steel standing rigging
- 1 Backstay: Bridle

- Rigid boom vang
- Genoa furling system with drum on the deck
- 2 Genoa tracks with piston adjusted traveller cars
- 2 Genoa sheet returns stainless steel fairleads
- Rigging run back to cockpit (except boom topping lift)
- Complete running rigging: Main halyard, Genoa halyard with clutch on mast and cleat, Boom topping lift with cleat on mast, Mainsheet, 2 Genoa sheets, 2 Automatic reefing system lines
- 4 Clutches, 4 Jamming cleats
- Main sheet on bridle, with fixed points on the roof

 - Fixed composite arch, with incorporated LED lighting
 - 2 Stand-up blocks for mainsail sheet

- Gas locker strut opening, 1 Stainless steel integrated telescopic swimming ladder

STARBOARD AFT: Interior stowage space

- Optional extra: Separate shower instead of this hanging locker

- Padded upholstery along the hull

AFT STARBOARD HEAD COMPARTMENT

- Access through salon
- 1 Sink, 1 Mixing tap hot/cold water, Shower
- 1 Manual Marine toilet with 21 US Gal rigid holding tank w/Drain
- Head cabinet, 1 Mirror, Toilet accessories, Hook
- 1 Overhead light
- 1 Opening portlight with curtains in side windows in the coaming

- Engine Yanmar Diesel 30 HP with Sail Drive
- Engine Control panel in cockpit
- Engine compartment: Soundproofing foam - Ventilation: 2 air intakes and 1 powered air expulsion fan
- 1 Alternator - 125 Amp

- 1 Rotomoulded diesel tank 34 US Gal - Gauge at the chart table - 1 Deck filler
- Filters: Sea water - Diesel - Water separator
- Fixed three blade propeller
- 1 Engine access through companionway - 3 access to engine by the sides of the companionway
