2011 Leopard 39 Sailing Catamaran built by Robertson & Caine. 3 cabin/2 head layout with office option in owner's suite - never chartered, lightly used. Spacious with plenty of areas for socializing, entertaining or just relaxing! Easy to operate with raised helm deck! Well kept one-owner boat!

"Festive" is a one owner boat! Delivered new and kept in the same slip for its life in Annapolis, Maryland - and enjoyed on the Chesapeake Bay! Never chartered - and lightly used - maintenance records available. The THREE cabin / TWO head layout offers a very stylish and spacious owner's suite to starboard that includes "the office option" and great guest accommodations to port. The ample cockpit dining space flows into the galley up and the very comfortable saloon area and gives you plenty of room to circulate and entertain!

Vessel Walkthrough and Details

You'll feel the spaciousness of this 39 Leopard from bow to stern, entering the cockpit from the wide platforms you'll enjoy a great entertaining /dining space protected by a continuous fiberglass hardtop. The raised helm stations starboard is also protected by a fiberglass hardtop and provides a stable platform for access to the working rigging and weather deck.

Entering the "up galley and saloon" area through the sturdy sliding doors flows well from the cockpit and has rich cherry wood finishes, Corian surfaces and large windows and natural light. Owner's stateroom and private head/shower to your starboard, and 2 guest staterooms and shared head/shower to your port.

Salon & Galley

The salon has a very open, light feel to the main area through its sturdy sliding door features an aft facing wide U-Shaped dining area - owner has converted to 2 tables and also has the original larger table too. There are panoramic windows and large opening hatches provide ample ventilation.

The "Galley Up" design truly lends itself to ease of entertaining and features ample cabinet and counter space. It's ergonomic layout with features soft curves, Corian Counter tops, Vitrifrigo 2 drawer frig/freezer, gimballed stove with oven and broiler, microwave, and great views!

Master Stateroom

You'll love the "OWNER'S SUITE," the starboard side is fully dedicated to the owners, featuring a privacy door, beautiful cherry finished cabinetry, plenty of storage and full-size hanging lockers, spacious master cabin to stern with double berth, bookshelf & reading lights, the private head & large stall shower is forward. You also have "office or vanity" space with desk space and overhead lighting.

Guest Staterooms

To port you'll find 2 guest rooms that also have double berths, ample storage, adjustable reading lights, full-size hanging lockers and a share head with shower.

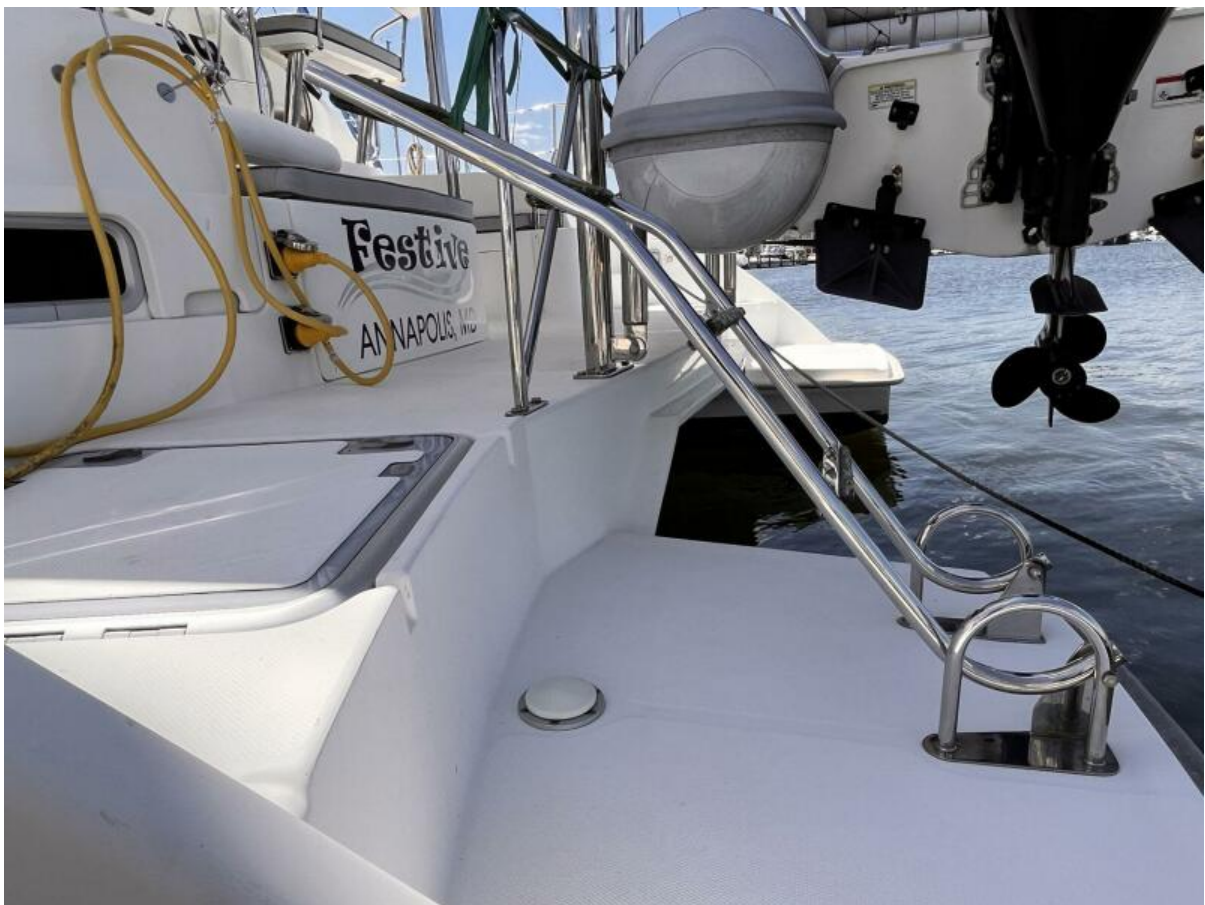


























































































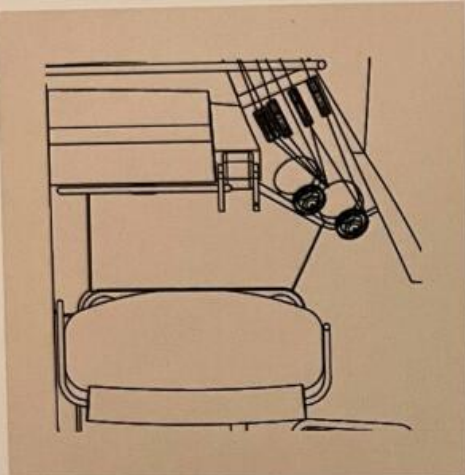

Helm Station:

Centralized sail control next to helm position allows for single handed operation, with the genoa and mainsail sheets and the mainsail traveler lines all led aft to the helm.

Huge rope storage compartment keeps deck clear of rope clutter.

Raised helm position allows panoramic view which is enhanced by a fixed port in the hardtop bimini.

Hull Chine:

Increases interior volume without compromising hull shape and minimizes wetted surface for more speed.

Water is deflected away from the hull thus keeping deck drier, while the radiused chine intersection reduces slapping.
