Summary/Description

1988 Ocean Alexander 42 Double Cabin

The 42 Double Cabin is a rare, but well laid out fast trawler. With good pedigree and lines, in such nice condition for her age, makes her a great find for a cruising couple, live aboard condo, Bahamas bound or even the Great Loop!

Her CAT 375hp motors run great have 1,760 hours, good maintenance and run her at an efficient 14.9 knot cruise (although she'll do 19.5 knots wide open). Loads of recent updates, including electronics, battery inverter/chargers, lithium batteries, solar panels for extended time at anchor, and a new Phaser 8.5kw generator.

This boat actively runs 700 miles a season in Florida, the Keys and the Bahamas and is very much dialed in and ready to go.

"Love N Luck" has is set up for cruising, but also extended time on the hook, with constant 120V on important circuits. Her LED lighting, lithium batteries and solar panels, offer easy living, with only 2 to 3 hours of generator use per day.

Batteries:

- Main engine starter batteries: 2x 8D NAPA Marine deep cycle, model 8276 (new December 2023)
- Generator starter battery: Group 27 deep cycle (new 2021)
- House batteries: 2x Ampere Time 300 Ah lithium, new in 2022 (total 600 Ah)

Generator:

• Phasor 8.5 kW with Kubota motor, 488 hours (new in 2021)

Charger/Controllers:



- Pro-Nautic 12-40P for starter and generator batteries Epever EPIPDB-COM-20 PWM charge controller for main starter and generator batteries during storage (also trickle charge to house batteries through DC to DC charger)
- Xantrex 818-2010 Freedom PRO Inverter/charger (2000 Watt/100 Amp charge) for house batteries, with separate electric panel to key circuits (*refrigeration, galley 120v outlet, microwave, fridge, freezer, rear cabin*)
- Victron DC to DC charger for house batteries (from alternator)

Solar:

• 400 Watt solar panels Victron 100/50 MPPT charge controller for house batteries from Solar

Notes:

• 8D Engine batteries (can be switched to parallel and have a charger connection to only one of them. The second charger lead goes to the generator battery.)

- 3208TA Major service (at approx. 1,450 hours): turbos rebuilt, new stainless exhaust risers and mufflers, all coolers cleaned and tested, new hoses, etc.
- Spare 25 x 22 propellers
- Displacement cruise at 8.7 to 9 kts at 1500 rpm, burning about 0.8 gals/hr.
- Planes 15.5 kts at about 2200 rpm, top speed about 19.5 kts.
