This aft cockpit Tayana 42 Cutter features fiberglass decks and therefore, she is known as one of the popular offshore cutters of this size.

Designer Robert Harris has incorporated into this solid double ender both seaworthiness and a spacious varnished teak interior layout for comfortable long range cruising. Overview

HULL & DECK:

- White hull, original gelcoat, blue boottop and sheer stripe, blue bottom.
- Modified full keel with cutaway forward and skeg-hung rudder for better sailing performance.
- Double-ended canoe stern transom.
- Original white fiberglass decks (many of these came with teak decks, so this is a sought after improvement never had teak).
- Solid fiberglass hull with no coring.
- Teak laid and caulked teak cockpit and trim (in excellent condition).
- S/S double stern and bow rails; vinyl-covered double lifelines with nylon netting with 32" tall lifelines and stanchions.
- Pedestal wheel steering with S/S wheel.
- Dark blue Sunbrella Dodger and Bimini with connector piece.
- 13 Hood S/S portlights with screens and shades.
- Aluminum davits for dinghy and rigid solar panel.
- Teak and S/S boom gallows.
- S/S folding swim ladder aft.
- 5 aluminum Bomar hatches with screens 2 new hatch lens in 2019.
- 5 Dorades with teak dorade boxes.
- S/S guard rails at mast.
- All thru hulls and seacocks are Groco bronze.

- 4481 hours as seen on the hour meter as of 6/23.
- This is not a Turbo-charged, engine for longer longevity.
- Yanmar instrument panel at forward end of cockpit.
- Binnacle-mounted throttle and gear shift controls.
- Kanzaki KM3P4 transmission transmission dipstick replaced.
- 1 1/4" shaft with pillow bearing support to a bronze stuffing box.
- New 18" x 11" RH 3 blade bronze prop.
- Dual Racor 500 MA fuel filters mounted on Filter Boss Commander external fuel pump to make it easier to switch filters or polish fuels.
- West Marine 12V oil change pump.
- Perko bronze saltwater strainer.
- At 5-6 knots, fuel burn approximately 1.5 gph @ 3100-3400 RPM.
- Engine oil pressure gauge runs high 80 instead of 40-50.
- Installed fuel gauge for fuel tanks.
- In Fall **2022**, all oil and filters changed.

- 2018 8 6V AGM house batteries (900 amp hours) under quarter berth.
- 2019 Deka 1-12V engine start battery with combiner switch.
- 2000w Kisae inverter charger for TV, microwave, etc (located aft of companionway stairs).
- 6 gallon Hot water heater 110V off engine.
- 2019 Balmar alternator, 165 amp, with regulator.
- 2022 435w solar panel on davits with 2019 Morningstar MPP4-25 controller.
- 110V & 12V DC circuit beaker panels.
- **2019** three 110w Sun Power flexible solar panels on Dodger and bimini, each controller (on sunny days, house batteries only need charging every other day).
- Xantrex meter shows house battery voltage and amp hours used.
- Balmar Smart gauge state of charge meter shows house and start battery voltage.
- Two 50' 30 amp shore power cable with 50 amp adapter.
- All cabin lighting are LED.
- All nav lights are LED (anchor light not working sold AS IS pigtail for anchor light is on boat).
- LPG detector not working sold AS IS.
- Yamaha gas generator (1600w) with 30 amp outlet can be conveyed at additional cost currently in storage.
- Several USB ports for charging phones, etc.
- 2022 Marinebeam wind generator very quiet in storage.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

- For six in two cabins, one spacious head and a main salon that sleeps two.
- Starting forward, the cabin has great enclosed storage lockers outboard, above the vee berth on both sides.
- In addition, there is a hanging locker and drawers to port as you enter the cabin.
- All the way forward in the forepeak, there is access to the anchor locker with split chain and rode storage compartments.



- The head, with separate stall shower, is forward of the salon to starboard. The shower is large and has smooth
 white surfaces, that are easy to clean. Also, sit-down bench and 10' long flexible shower hose with hot/cold mixing
 faucet.
- Raritan manual head drains into 35 gallon holding tank that can be emptied via Jabsco macerator pump, or pumped out through deck fitting. New
- pump for head.
- Opposite the head to port is another large hanging locker.
- The main salon has a fixed table.
- There is an L-shaped settee to starboard (with optional insert to turn this into a double), and two swivel chairs with teak table to port.
- Outboard of the dinette are abundant storage and bookshelves.
- The nav station is aft of the port settee with full electronics and A/C D/C electric panel controls.
- The double quarter berth cabin is to port behind the nav station with a full hanging locker and storage.
- The large galley is to starboard and open, with comfortable working spaces and numerous lockers.

GALLEY:

- Large U-shaped galley to starboard with separated counters fore and aft so two people can work; 4 long narrow drawers beside stove; 4 more drawers beside sink for utensils and cutlery.
- Additional counter space available on slide-up teak stove cover.
- Force 10 3-burner gimballed propane stove and over with both baking and broiling elements.
- **New** fiberglass propane tank (room for 2) in vented fuel locker provide about 2 months of cooking each, and also supply the BBQ through its own separate valve.
- Microwave oven is easily removed if desired; original shelf and louvered sliding door can be reinstalled.
- Separate refrigerator with top-opening lid and front opening door, freezer with top-opening lid, both 6.5 cubic feet.
- Two separate DC powered Frigibot refrigeration systems for fridge and freezer with digital thermostats and choice of water or air cooling (2016); water cooling is more energy efficient, air cooling is useful in boatyard or when cleaning raw water strainer. 2022 lines vacuumed and dried, **new** refrigerant installed and **new** controller for fridge.
- Hot and cold water supplied through main faucet, supplied by on-demand water pump from two S/S water tanks below cabin sole totaling 100 gallons fresh water.
- 6 gallon Seaward F-700 hot water heater by engine coolant or shore power.
- Backup foot pump with separate spout provides alternate way to obtain fresh water from tanks.

ELECTRONICS:

Nav Desk and Main Cabin:

- Standard Horizon Matrix AIS GX2100 VHF radio with AIS receiver, DSC support with SOS call button and remote mic / controller at helm.
- Wifi connection to Garmin chartplotter at helm allows smartphone or tablet Garmin Helm app at nav desk (or anywhere on the boat) to see exactly what is being displayed on the chartplotter, including its instrument readouts, and to interact with it to see other chartplotter/instrument readout screens.
- Raymarine S100 wireless autopilot remote control allows autopilot to be steered from nav desk or anywhere on the boat.
- Garmin GMI10 remote display shows true and apparent wind, depth, GPS position, speed over bottom, and

- Water-wheel transducer in lazarette shows speed through the water.
- In-hull Airmar P79 depth/sonar 200kHz transducer port side aft of V-berth.
