There is a raised bridge deck with centerline helm and wraparound settees. Below is an air conditioned cherry wood salon and fully equipped galley, with a single stateroom with en-suite head forward. She is driven by a desirable twin Caterpillar C12 710hp engine package with 1,006 original hours, that will give her a cruise/top speed of about 28/34 knots.

The Albemarle 410 Express Fisherman is a sight to behold. Striking lines, a dramatic Carolina-style flare, and unadulterated fishing systems adorn the exterior. Elegant refinements and comfortable appointments grace the cabin. And in her engine room, twin Cats supply speed and responsiveness. The 410 has a large cockpit equipped with a standard live well, freezer, ice / bait cooler, tackle storage, oversized fishboxes, and transom door. Two steps up lead into the large helm area with a centered dash and wheel for maximum visibility and control. Wrap-around bench seating on both sides frames the helm and provides ample room for long runs out.
