Built specifically to fit the needs of this Original Owner, she was built with a huge Cockpit Mezzanine, complete with Stainless Steel lined Bait Freezer, Ice Dump, bait and drink boxes. Huge Transom fishbox and Livewell (these are also Stainless steel lined). Teak cover and coaming, Teak cockpit floor and centerline cockpit engine access. Twin 3412 Caterpillar diesel engines, cruise nicely at 30 kts with a 36 kt top speed. SeaKeeper 9, twin Northern Lights generators, triple Garmin touch screen MFD's. Huge flybridge, Bow Thruster, tons of Flybridge seating and storage. Beautiful Salon, 3 stateroom with 2 head/showers and built in Rod/Tackle storage.

## Walkthrough- Salon and Galley

- The salon is really where you really get the sense of the Size and Beam of "Poor Girl"
- Salon Dimensions are 9'6" deep and 14'6" wide with over 7' of Headroom
- Enter through a lockable, hinged stbd side door. The door features a faux teak exterior, varnished interior
- Along the Stbd side is a Granite countertop with the Main AC/DC breaker and switch panel and remote-control panels for both of the Generators inside of the cabinet
- A stbd side sofa (over 6' long) runs along the stbd side with storage beneath, suitable for 6' rods
- There are End Table at each end of the Stbd sofa, each has 2 drawers
- The entry flooring is teak and holly with the remainder being carpeted
- A full carpet runner protects the Salon Carpet from wear
- An L-shaped sofa (cream colored Ultra Leather) runs along the aft and port side of the Salon, with storage below and with End Table and Lamps on each (drawers in one End Table and Bottle Storage beneath the other)
- A triangular shaped Ottoman (same upholstery as the sofa) serves as a footrest for the L-Shaped Sofa
- Forward from the Salon is the Galley with Corian counter tops and Two Bar Stools on the aft side of the Bar
- Up one step to the Galley Level and the U-shaped Dinette Table that runs along the port side, with a Corian topped Dining Table and strategically placed 110v outlets for use.
- The Galley peninsula extends from the Stbd side and features a Corian Countertop
- Teak and Holly floor for the Galley Floor
- There are SubZero refrigerator and Freezer beneath the Counter. (2) 700 BF and (2) 700 BR units
- There is a large Two Layer Wine Bottle Safe that is concealed in the "Corner" of the galley countertop
- The Galley sink is a Corian Undermount, quite large, with a Combination Spray head/faucet with a Corian Cuttingboard top for the Sink
- (3) large Galley storage drawers
- Pull out Trash and Recycle Storage containers beneath the sink
- Kenyon 2 burner electric Glasstop stove
- (4) huge storage drawers
- Black & Decker coffee machine
- Slide out Drawer for the Toaster Oven
- Slide-out upper storage drawer
- GE Profile Microwave Convection oven
- (2) zones of Salon Heat/Air Conditioning for the Salon/galley
- Dimmable overhead lighting
- LED Rope lighting in the upper Valances
- Large Side and Aft salon windows are tinted
- (2) salon stereo/TV speakers
- 40 inch LG flat panel TV in a cabinet at the Port forward space in the Galley, viewable from the Entire Salon
- Samsung DVD/BlueRay Player
- Denon stereo receiver
- DirecTV receiver
- Sony CD Player
- Integra DVD player

## Walkthrough- Lower Accommodations space

- From the Galley, down a 6-step stairway is the Lower Accommodations space
- Central Vacuum connection at the base of the stairway
- Whisper wall panels line a Nice/Wide hallway
- At the base of the stairs, on the port side is the Guest Head and Shower

### GUEST HEAD AND SHOWER

- Teak and Holly floor in the Guest head with mirrored ceiling
- Corian Countertop with undermount sink
- Upper medicine cabinet storage with three mirrored doors
- Large full standing height Fiberglass Shower with acrylic shower door and Spray head shower fixture
- Head Hunter elongated electric flushing toilet

### GUEST BUNK ROOM

- Forward of the guest head is the bunk room
- Lockable privacy door
- it's own zone of Heating/Air Conditioning
- Upper bunk is a Single
- Lower Bunk is a Double
- End Table with storage cabinets
- (2) reading lamps
- Upper storage cabinets
- Laundry is located in a Cabinet within the Bunk room
- Splendide Washer/Dryer combination unit and 2 storage drawers

### ROD STORAGE ROOM

- Forward of the Guest Bunk room is the Formal Rod and Tackle Locker
- stand-up room for multiple rod and reel combinations
- Storage Cabinet
- Overhead light

### FORWARD VIP STATEROOM

- with lockable privacy door, the VIP suite is located in the forward portion of the boat. There is more than 7' of headroom here
- Island Queen sized bed with 3 large storage drawers beneath
- (2) upper sleeping bunks, one along each side. Perfect for kids/grandkids, also suitable for luggage/duffle bags
- (2) reading lamps
- (2) end table/nightstands, 110v electric plugs here
- 13 inch Toshiba TV/DVD player
- Stbd side Short hanging locker for clothes (with light), with 3 storage drawers beneath
- Port side Long Hanging Locker with light

## MASTER STATEROOM

- located at the base of the Stairway on the Stbd side is the Master Suite
- Pedestal Queen Ben, with a Beautiful Headboard along the stbd side
- storage drawers beneath the bed
- (2) end tables/night stands with 110v electric power
- 13 inch Toshiba TV/DVD player above a "make-up" counter and mirror

## MASTER HEAD AND SHOWER

- Forward in the Master Suite is the Head, with privacy door
- Teak and Holly floor
- Mirrored ceiling with overhead lighting
- Corian Countertops
- (3) door mirrored Medicine Cabinet
- Fresh water tang gauge is located within one of these medicine cabinet doors
- Very large Stand-Up shower with Spray head and Acrylic shower door

## Walkthrough- Engine room, Bilge and Mechanical

- Complete Cooling System service (Heat Exchanges, Aftercoolers removed, cleaned/tested/painted) Summer 2023
- Exhaust Risers replaced 2016
- Engine Room access is via a large opening in center line of the Mezzanine, and drops you directly into the Middle of the Pump Room
- Livewell switching, Fresh water Switching (dockside to tank, dockside to Fresh water system), located at the Engine room entry
- Engine Room fan switches
- Dometic Eskimo Ice Machine, 540 lbs/day, with a Very Short discharge hose directly into the Ice Dump
- 110 volt Raw water pump for the Eskimo
- Bilge Alley provides access to the Aft Bilge, and runs between the Fuel Tanks
- Fuel Cross Over hose between the fuel tanks
- Gaff and Brush Storage in the overhead of the Bilge Alley
- Tides Dripless Rudder seals
- Sea Star Power Assist steering system
- SeaFrost Freezer unit for Bait Freezer
