A lovely Flag blue Awlgripped hull, with varnished trim (not too much)! **RUTH ANN** is a Classic, built with the integrity and uncompromised quality by Wilbur Yachts in SW Harbor, ME. **RUTH ANN** features dual helms, a large aft cockpit, a main salon with pull-out settee, with a full "down" galley, large enclosed head and separate shower, as well a very large vee berth with filler, shelves, outboard hanging locker. Her Cat diesel has only 2100 hours and just had \$2,000 spent to have her heat exchanger and oil coolers cleaned, and oil and filters changed. Highlights include new batteries, bow thruster, air conditioning and heat, as well as buss heater off the engine, autopilot, 12V Lewmar windlass, Garmin GPS and much more to complete her inventory. Please call us for your inspection and thank you for your interest. She has been stored under cover for last 15 winters.

Overview

HULL & DECK:

- Hull #26.
- Awlgripped hull topsides - Flag Blue, snow white boot stripe, green bottom, all in excellent condition.
- Beige fiberglass decks.
- Varnished teak exterior trim and toerails.
- Solid fiberglass hull.
- Polished S/S ladder with teak treads.
- S/S bow rail; teak bowsprit with S/S anchor roller.
- Teak swim platform with S/S ladder and weaver dinghy davits.
- Varnished Fir mast and boom to hoist dinghy.
- Installed hull spray rails and lifting strakes at waterline, which did not come originally with vessel. Now, vessel handles the seas much better.
- Installed hot and cold cockpit shower.
- Approximately 10-15 years ago, all salon windows removed, rebedded, and trim painted.
- Dual helms with teak rimmed Edson wheels and hydraulic steering.
- 12V Lewmar windlass with dual action foot pedals, and dual helm controls.
- **Side Power bow thruster.**
- Center windshield opens; windshield windows have Textaline covers.
- Protected prop via skeg hung rudder.
- Navy blue flybridge bimini and flybridge cover.
- White vinyl flybridge cushions.
- Awning to place over boom for cockpit awning.

Holding: 15 gallons in poly tank with deck discharge and y-valve to overboard discharge.

- Buss heater when engine is running.
- 2-12V phone charger outlets.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

- Four four in a "Herreshoff-style" interior with white bulkhead, varnished teak trim and a stunning varnished teak and holly sole.
- Chain locker forward followed aft by vee berths with a filler for large double berth, with shelves outboard, hatch overhead, and lockers below.
- Further ventilation is supplied by 2 bronze screened cabin portlights.
- A curtain draws across the forward cabin to create a private sleeping area.
- Next aft is a hanging locker.
- Opposite to starboard is an enclosed head, hot and cold sink, separate stall shower, and a Vacuflush fresh water head.
- To port is the "down galley" with 6'2" headroom.

GALLEY/MAIN CABIN:

- S/S single sink, Seaward Princess 3 burner LPG stove with oven, and a Norcold 12V-110V refrigerator-freezer located under the counter. There are dish lockers and extra cabinets.
- Up several steps to the main salon with lower helm to starboard with an EZZ-IN moveable swivel helm chair.
- To port is a settee berth which extends to a double berth with beige ultra-suede cushions and backrest cushions.
- There is a moveable teak 4 legged dining table for salon or cockpit use.
- Extra handrails have been installed overhead and there are numerous reading lights; and a brass lantern on the aft bulkhead.
- This attractive interior is an ideal layout for a couple to cruise with occasional guests.
- One steps into the cockpit from a starboard offset door. The cockpit is spacious with an LPG locker vented for 2 tanks under forward gunwale.
