Originally christened as the "WHY?", the current owner entrusted the awe-inspiring vessel to the skilled craftsmen at Jarrett Bay Boatworks in 2012, where it underwent a comprehensive and complete reconstruction and redesign.

Following its relaunch in 2013, the "J&B" underwent a series of notable enhancements that truly elevated its status. A 3' 1" hull extension was seamlessly integrated, accompanied by the installation of state-of-the-art Caterpillar C-32 main engines, new generators, an exquisite American/Bausch tower, and the addition of a bow thruster. The vessel's transformation also encompassed a striking new paint job, cutting-edge electronics, a gyroscopic stabilization system, advanced HVAC technology, revamped plumbing, and an entirely remodeled interior, among numerous other upgrades.

The incredible journey of the "J&B" garnered significant attention from various esteemed publications, with numerous magazines and articles chronicling the historic rebuild of this extraordinary sportfisher. Located in the picturesque setting of Newport Beach, CA, the "J&B" awaits her new owner and is ready to captivate all who lay eyes upon this legend.

2013-2014 Refit

The J&B was completely stripped down and rebuilt at Jarrett Bay Boatworks in North Carolina. Marc Phillips who originally helped build the boat was employed as project manager to oversee the complete refit of this timeless sport fisher bringing modern technology and machinery to the Classic Sonny Hines design.

space underneath. A custom-built Release Marine table sits in front of the sofa, offering the versatility to transform into a full dining table, perfect for entertaining guests. On the starboard side, the entertainment center discreetly houses a large flat-screen TV, cleverly concealed by an electric lift.

Moving forward, you will find the galley adorned with beautiful, raised panel cabinet doors and adorned with rich granite countertops. To the port side of the galley, a U-shaped settee awaits, accompanied by a custom, hand-built table, creating a cozy and inviting dining area.

Descending the stairs, the master stateroom awaits on the starboard side, featuring a comfortable walk-around queen bed. Ample storage space, including a spacious closet and vanity, can be found on the starboard side of the stateroom. The ensuite head is located forward and boasts a generous-sized head and a luxurious master tub/shower, providing a private sanctuary for relaxation.

On the port side, the guest stateroom awaits, offering upper and lower bunks adorned with custom bedding. The ensuite head, located forward, features a full head and shower, ensuring the utmost comfort and convenience for guests.

At the bow of the vessel, you will discover the VIP stateroom, featuring a walk-around queen bed adorned with custom bedding. The ensuite head, located on the port side, offers a full head and shower, providing a private retreat for guests.
