The master stateroom is forward with a centerline island queen berth, large head and stall shower and provides abundant storage in closets, drawers and lockers. The guest cabin has a queen berth, a second head compartment and lots of storage. The salon features a lower helm station with pedestal helm chair and a "U" shaped lounge with 360 degree visibility and seating for the whole family. The well laid out galley features a full size fridge/freezer, three burner electric stove & oven, a microwave oven plus cabinet space. The cockpit is large with coaming lockers, a wet bar, and built-in top loading freezer box and transom door. 
