Summary/Description

"By The Bay" is a meticulously maintained Island Packet 31 with stainless steel ports and lines led aft from the factory. Her owner has detailed lists of her inventory and you just can't find one cleaner.

Three meticulous owners in this boat's history give you a well maintained, beautiful cruiser. Her hull shines and nothing has been let go. New and newer canvas give her a fresh appearance and she just has that crisp look...even after all these years.

Nothing can take the place of continual maintenance. She shines.

Accomodations

Starting forward is the large v-berth with custom mattress, hanging lockers, drawers, opening overhead hatch and ports. There is a private entry to the head which is next aft to starboard. There is a marine head with holding tank, integral shower and stainless steel sink. To port is a hanging locker.

The main salon is next aft with "L" shaped settee to starboard, facing settee to port and Island Packet's signature bulkhead mounted table.

To starboard of the companionway is the large quarter berth and the nav station which folds up to form a bulkhead for privacy. To port is the "U" shaped galley.
