Both the pilothouse and in the salon/cabin below have air conditioning and heat.

Liberty has 1200 hours on her 370hp Yanmar engines and 530 hours on the Westerbeke generator, the boat cruises easily in the mid 20 knot range so you can get around your cruising grounds quickly and easily. It is easy to see that *Liberty* has been very well-cared for by her current (and previous) owners, it's unlikely you'll find an early 2000's "Downeast Express" cruiser as clean as this.

Liberty has been stored in indoor heated storage with regular cleaning and maintenance, she just had her Spring detail and is currently in the water on the dock and ready for your summer cruising season.
