An oversized square deck hatch with a retractable shade and screen, along with four eye-level screened ports stir an airy, spacious feeling. Removable carpet, two cedar lined clothes closets, flat screen entertainment packages and lined privacy drapes are all standard equipment extras that make the 290 one of the roomiest cruisers you'll find under 30-feet. Key cabin options include a 10,000 BTU air conditioner/heater, a generator, teak and holly flooring and an accessory pillow/towel package.
