The design weight with 2 X 1,200hp MAN's was 47,800 lbs., so it's quite close. At that weight, the boat should run about 44 knots according to calculations. The original ZF propellers made the predicted speed, so your missing speed is in the new props. Please let me know if you have any other questions. **Best regards, Mike Peters**
