- **2014** Rebuilt rudder when bottom was blasted.
- 3 opening deck hatches.
- Gray bimini top.
- One dorade vent.
- Nicro solar vents.

ENGINE & MECHANICAL:

- Yanmar 3GM30, 24 hp diesel, FWC, Serial # 06304, **rebuilt and replaced in 2014**.
- 376 hours as seen on the hour meter.
- Kanzaki 2.64:1 transmission.
- 1 1/4" S/S shaft; 2 blade bronze folding prop.
- Racor fuel filter.

ELECTRICAL:

- 12V DC & 110V AC systems with circuit breaker panels.
- **2021** 2-6V batteries in series; **2019** 1-12V engine start battery.
- 20 amp automatic battery charger with solar panel.
- Solar panel to trickle charge the batteries.
